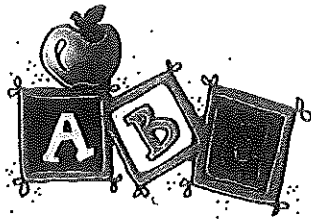
Breakfast is free for all students who arrive at

Lunch is available Monday - Thursday for \$2.75; nutrition information available in the lunchroom.

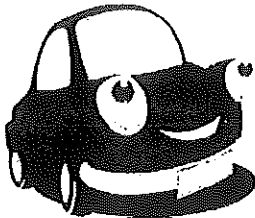

Lunch Account update

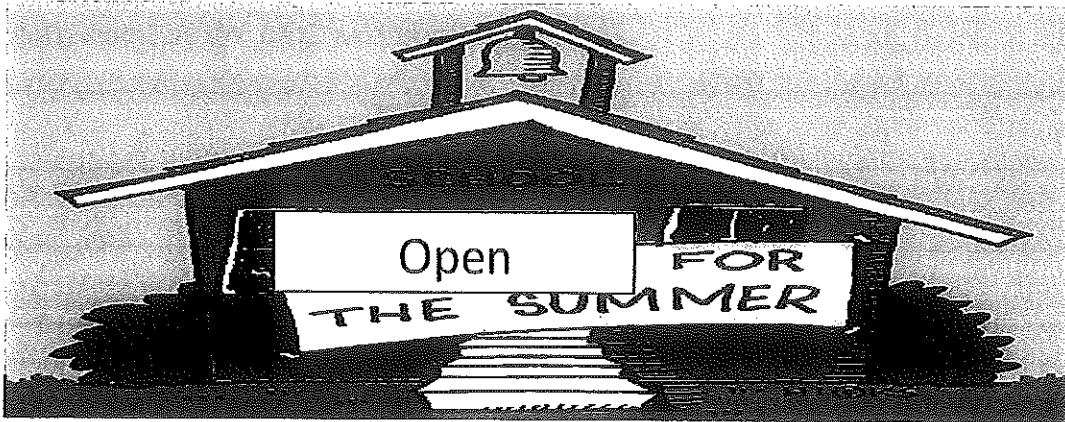
Dear Parents,

You will need to bring the following items to your appointment:

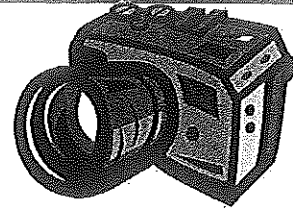
