

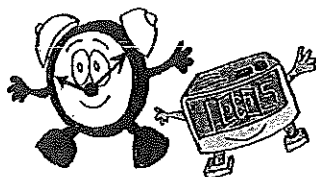

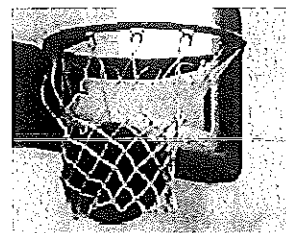
**Parents, Grandparents, Guardians,

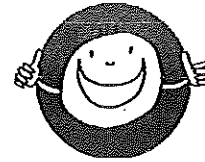
Lunch Account update
