TRANSPORTATION

Students will be traveling to and returning from Flagstaff in a Franklin Phonetic School vehicle. Students may leave with parents after the performance only with advanced written notice. It is encouraged that students stay with the school group until the end of the festival weekend, as it is a way of building camaraderie between the students and staff.

LODGING

Students will be lodging at the Embassy Suites in Flagstaff, covered by Franklin Phonetic School. Female students may not be in the room of a male student for any reason. Male students may not be in the room of a female student for any reason. Students who do not follow this rule will have an immediate consequence. Consequences may include loss of all festival privileges, and/or being sent home at parents' expense.

MEALS

Students need to bring funds for lunch and dinner on Friday and dinner on Saturday. Student's made-to-order breakfast is included in the hotel stay. Students will need to pay \$5 to Franklin Phonetic School by Thursday April 26, 2018, to cover the students' lunch Saturday afternoon.

COST

Students that are selected to participate in an Honor Ensemble are required to pay a \$20 Registration fee to cover festival site expenses, per the Arizona Music Educators Association. Students are also required to pay for their own meals (3).

BEHAVIOR

Students must abide by all school rules while on this trip. Students must sign and return the music festival contract by Thursday, April 26, 2018. Students must prepare their music prior to the rehearsal on May 4, 2018. It is imperative that students prepare ahead of time so that rehearsal time can be used efficiently and effectively. Choir students are expected to have all of their music memorized before the festival weekend. Students that require extra help learning their festival music are encouraged to seek the help of their director.

ATTIRE

Students will need to wear their black Franklin Music shirts on Friday. On Saturday, students must wear a set of *formal* clothes for the performance. Franklin Phonetic School dress code applies to all clothing. Bathing suits must be one piece or a tankini that covers the midriff. Boys swimwear must be shorts style.
