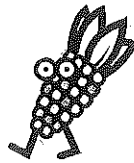

Franklin Fall Festival is on the way. Oct 25th 3 – 7pm. Come on over for some great fun, a chili cook off (spots still open information attached).



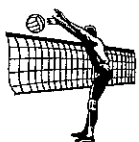
