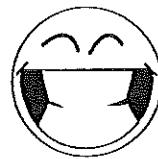

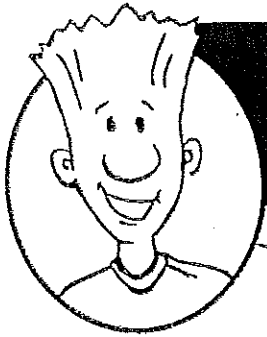

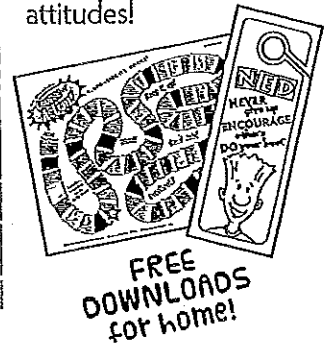

Strep Throat

We have had a case of strep throat in 5th grade.

Symptoms

Children will usually get sick 3-5 days after exposure.

Illness begins suddenly with fever,
sore throat, headache & stomachache are common.
The throat and tonsils are often swollen and beefy red.
Strep will sometimes cause foul smelling breath.

How is it diagnosed?

A doctor will conduct a strep test.

How is it treated?

Antibiotics are often used to treat strep throat.
Ibuprofen may be given for pain.

How can it be prevented?

Avoid close contact with contagious people.
Children may return to school 24 hours after antibiotics
have been started
