## Spalding:

**Phonogram Tested:** e, h, i, j, k, l, d, g

**Review:** a, c-z

**Introduced:** er, ir, ur, wor, ear

**Cut and paste:** z, b

**Reading:** We have story time each day where we read picture books and we are continuing to discuss elements of narratives. We will begin to learn about the elements of an informative. We will continue learning about vowels and rhyming words.

**Handwriting:** Write a,c,d,f,g,o,s,qu correctly starting at 2 'clock. We will continue to work on writing e,h,i,j,k,l,m,n,p,r,t,u,v,w,x,y,z staying between the lines. Then we will learn how to write b. We are continuing to use house paper during writing. Tall letters go in the attic, short letters are written where the person lives and some letters such as g, j, q, y go in the basement. We use this language in the classroom, it may be beneficial for them at home too!
