Poem "#6" - Please study our New poem with your child. This can be part of their homework. : We will work on this poem for 2 weeks. The oral presentation will be on November 3rd.

Objectives for this week:

Spalding - Phonograms w, x. Work on counting sounds in a given word. Writing practice of phonograms. Review of a, b,c, d, e, f, g, h, i, j, k, l, m, n, o, p, q, r, s, t, u, v using the Phonogram Circus DVD.

Reading - Our Little books are a bit on hold. We are going to continue to work on word families and picture clues. Please have your child listen to the Phonogram Circus DVD at home. This will be a great review tool.

Math - Continue working on counting to 20 orally, written # 0 - 20, Identifying objects 1-20, charts / graphs and patterns. WE are also exploring counting backwards!

The exciting news is - We are adding now!!! Please help your child accurately count to be correct. I ask the students to mark as the count out loud. This helps them stay one to one.



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Language Arts - Listening skills, following directions, word families, nouns, and identifying the main idea in a story or selection. We will also be working on learning the poem #6. The oral test will be on Friday, November 3rd..

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Science - This week we will be studying a new topic ,"Our Earth". What is a country , continent, ocean and seas. Where are we in relation to other countries/places?

Social Studies - We will be studying different ways that people track time. Calendars, clocks, timers.
