Objectives for this week:

Spalding - Phonograms m, s. Work on counting sounds in a given word. Writing practice of phonograms. Review of a, b,c, d, e, f, g, h, i, j,, n, o, p, q, r using the Phonogram Circus DVD.

Reading - We will start with our Little books and work on word families and picture clues. Please have your child listen to the Phonogram Circus DVD at home. This will be a great review tool.

Math - Continue working on counting to 20 orally, written # 0 - 20, Identifying objects 1-20, charts / graphs and patterns. We are also starting to skip count by 2's.

Language Arts - Listening skills, following directions, word families, nouns, and identifying the characters in a story. We will also be working on learning the poem #5. The oral test will be on Friday, October 20th.



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Science - This week we will be looking at matter. What is matter?

Social Studies - We will continue working on understanding the working parts of a community. What we can do as students for our communities.
