Dear Franklin School Families,

We are almost $\frac{1}{4}$ through our school year. I am proud of the job that all of us are doing. Both campuses demonstrate safe, well-ordered classrooms. It is very exciting to see how much the students are achieving. Tom and I are proud that the tradition that began back in 1996 is still continuing. Unfortunately, every year it becomes more difficult to do our jobs. School funding has not kept up with legislative requirements and inflation. Reporting requirements and paperwork have increased over ten-fold. As a result, a task that could be completed by one or two people back in 1996, now takes many individuals and many days. We know that everyone has been hit hard by inflation and rising costs. In spite of these increased costs, Tom and I know how hard the employees work. Last year we wanted to honor the efforts of our employees by giving a raise. We expected that the Arizona Department of Education would honor their promise to increase school funding. Unfortunately, this did not happen!

I do not know if you are aware that neither the Prescott Valley School nor the Sunnyslope campus will ever be owned by Tom and Cindy Franklin. Currently the mortgage for the non-profit corporation for the Prescott School is held by a group of bond investors and is scheduled to be paid off in about 22 years. However, if the bond investors feel that we are not bringing in enough revenue they have the right to ask that the 6 million dollar mortgage be paid immediately. This would affect both campuses of Franklin School. One perfect opportunity for us to increase funding is to actively solicit the tax credit donation program. If all of our families contributed, they would not only save on taxes, but they would also help our school. Please use the enclosed tax credit brochure to tell others about our school.

My hope is that the school will continue to be successful and continue for the next 22 years and beyond. However, right now we need your assistance. Please talk to your accountant and see if you can help us. Because we are a nonprofit, credits can be applied to both state and federal taxes.

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Estimadas familias de la escuela Franklin,

Ya llevamos casi 1/4 de nuestro año escolar. Estoy orgulloso del trabajo que todos estamos haciendo. Ambos campus demuestran aulas seguras y bien ordenadas. Es muy emocionante ver cuánto están logrando los estudiantes. Tom y yo estamos orgullosos de que la tradición que comenzó en 1996 continúe. Lamentablemente, cada año se vuelve más difícil hacer nuestro trabajo. La financiación escolar no ha estado a la altura de los requisitos legislativos y la inflación. Los requisitos de presentación de informes y el papeleo se han multiplicado por diez. Como resultado, una tarea que en 1996 podían realizar una o dos personas, ahora requiere muchas personas y muchos días. Sabemos que todo el mundo se ha visto muy afectado por la inflación y el aumento de los costes. A pesar de estos mayores costos, Tom y yo sabemos lo duro que trabajan los empleados. El año pasado quisimos honrar los esfuerzos de nuestros empleados dándoles un aumento. Esperábamos que el Departamento de Educación de Arizona cumpliera su promesa de aumentar la financiación escolar. ¡Desafortunadamente esto no sucedió!

No sé si usted sabe que ni la Escuela Prescott Valley ni el campus de Sunnyslope jamás serán propiedad de Tom y Cindy Franklin. Actualmente, la hipoteca de la corporación sin fines de lucro para la Escuela Prescott está en manos de un grupo de inversores en bonos y está previsto que se liquide en unos 22 años. Sin embargo, si los inversores en bonos consideran que no estamos generando suficientes ingresos, tienen derecho a pedir que se pague inmediatamente la hipoteca de 6 millones de dólares. Esto afectaría a ambos campus de la Escuela Franklin. Una oportunidad perfecta para que aumentemos los fondos es solicitar activamente el programa de donación de crédito fiscal. Si todas nuestras familias contribuyeran, no sólo ahorrarían en impuestos, sino que también ayudarían a nuestra escuela. Mi esperanza es que la escuela siga teniendo éxito y continúe durante los próximos 22 años y más. Sin embargo, ahora mismo necesitamos su ayuda. Por favor hable con su contador y vea si puede ayudarnos. Debido a que somos una organización sin fines de lucro, los créditos se pueden aplicar a impuestos tanto estatales como federales.
