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**Math -** Continue working on counting to 100 orally, written # 0 - 20, Identifying objects 1-50, charts / graphs and patterns. We are also exploring counting backwards!

The exciting news is - We are now looking at number patterns and learning about place value. We are continuing on adding. Please help your child accurately count to be correct. I ask the students to mark as the count out loud. This helps them stay one to one.

**Language Arts -** Listening skills, following directions, word families, nouns, and identifying the plot in a story or selection.

**Science -** In kindergarten, students use their senses to help them make observations about the world around them, recognizing patterns and the structures and functions of living and non-living things. For the next 2 weeks we will be looking at patterns and living and nonliving things.
