Dear Parents and Families.

Hello April!!! Spring is here! We hope you had a wonderful weekend. We are looking forward to another fun-filled week of learning and growth in the preschool classroom. Here's what's happening!



1. Monday Let's Plant

Teacher will introduce a small center to paint flowers to make a garden.

2. Tuesday Plants are Beautiful

Teacher will introduce a small center to use playdough as soil and plant a plant.

3. Wednesday Flower Soup

Teacher will introduce a small center to make flower soup with water and paper flowers.

4. Thursday Nature Walk

Teacher will ask the student where they think they will find flowers. Then go on a nature scavenger hunt walk outside.

5. Friday Lets Count I see a Rainbow

Teacher will ask students to count seeds, sort seeds, and color a butterfly.

Learning Focus:

- Writing the Alphabet: We will continue to practice writing letters, focusing on letter formation and recognizing both uppercase and lowercase letters. Your child will be encouraged to write their name and other simple words.
- Numbers: We will begin working on writing and recognizing numbers, starting with 1 through 10. Hands-on activities will help the children learn counting and number recognition.
- Sounding Out Words: Each week, we will focus on sounding out simple words and practice writing them. This will help your child understand the connection between letters and sounds and build early reading skills.
- Fine Motor Skills: We will continue to strengthen fine motor skills through activities like cutting with scissors, drawing, coloring, and building with blocks. These activities help improve hand-eye coordination and prepare the children for writing.
