
# Pre-K NEWS

Dear Parents and Families.

Hello April!!! Spring is here! We hope you had a wonderful weekend. We are looking forward to another fun-filled week of learning and growth in the preschool classroom. Here's what's happening!



## 1. Monday What is Recycling

Teacher will introduce a small center to learn what recycling is and how we can do it.

## 2. Tuesday I Can Help the Earth

Teacher will introduce a small center to talk about Earth and color headbands.

# 3. Wednesday Sensory Exploration

Teacher will introduce a small center to sort different materials such as cardboard, aluminum and paper.

## 4. Thursday What Colors do We See

Teacher will ask the student why they think green and blue are colors for Earth. Then use playdough to make an Earth.

## 5. Friday Fine Motor Skills

Teacher will ask students to use q-tips to paint Earth using their fine motor skills.

#### **Learning Focus:**

- Writing the Alphabet: We will continue to practice writing letters, focusing on letter formation and recognizing both uppercase and lowercase letters. Your child will be encouraged to write their name and other simple words.
- Numbers: We will begin working on writing and recognizing numbers, starting with 1 through 10. Hands-on activities will help the children learn counting and number recognition.
- Fine Motor Skills: We will continue to strengthen fine motor skills through activities like cutting with scissors, drawing, coloring, and building with blocks. These activities help improve hand-eye coordination and prepare the children for writing.
