Themes:

1. **Monday Ocean Animals**
Teacher will introduce a small center to learn about ocean animals..
 2. **Tuesday What is a Seahorse**
Teacher will introduce a small center to learn about seahorses.
 3. **Wednesday Sharks are Different**
Teacher will introduce a small center to learn sharks and why they are different.
 4. **Thursday Crabs are Colorful**
Teacher will ask the student about different colored crabs.

Teacher will ask students to think about why octopus have 8 legs.
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Learning Focus:

- **Writing the Alphabet:** We will continue to practice writing letters, focusing on letter formation and recognizing both uppercase and lowercase letters. Your child will be encouraged to write their name and other simple words.
 - **Numbers:** We will begin working on writing and recognizing numbers, starting with 1 through 10. Hands-on activities will help the children learn counting and number recognition.
 - **Fine Motor Skills:** We will continue to strengthen fine motor skills through activities like cutting with scissors, drawing, coloring, and building with blocks. These activities help improve hand-eye coordination and prepare the children for writing.
