Phonograms. Oral and written phonogram practice occurs daily. Students will take a practice test on Thursday, and a final assessment on Friday. Thirty focus phonograms will be chosen each week and listed on the newsletter.

Math. Instruction will be focused on the Arizona Academic Standards.

5th grade

Divisibility, equal groups, problems with fractions, ratio, rate, adding and subtracting fractions that have a common denominator.

Using a compass and straight edge, prime, composite numbers, prime factorization, problems about fraction of a group, subtracting mixed numbers with regrouping, and reducing fractions.
