Thanks to everyone that has sent lids in. We no longer need anymore.


"150 Years of Christmas Memories" Prescott Christmas Parade Saturday, Dec 6<sup>th</sup>

#### The bugs are on the crawl

One of the most unprejudiced creatures on earth is a louse. They do not care if you are rich, poor, clean, dirty, cute, ugly, big, fat, skinny or tall. They do not care about religion, a clean house or living in the boonies. It can be freezing cold or blistering heat and they keep surviving on our heads. Lice are transmitted as easily as the common cold. We have had a confirmed case in Kindergarten.

#### Facts:

Head lice are transmitted mainly through close head to head contact.

Children working or playing in small groups are all at risk for transmitting head lice.

Head lice may also be transmitted by sharing personal items (i.e. combs, brushes, etc.)

Parents, caregivers, and siblings may acquire head lice from younger children through sharing pillows, beds, towels, brushes or combs.

It is important to get rid of lice as soon as possible so that other members of the family or close associates may avoid infestation.

Head lice are not prejudice!

Strep Throat
We have had a case of strep throat in Kindergarten & 2<sup>nd</sup> grade.

#### Symptoms

Children will usually get sick 3-5 days after exposure.

Illness begins suddenly with fever,
sore throat, headache & stomachache are common.

The throat and tonsils are often swollen and beefy red.
Strep will sometimes cause foul smelling breath.

#### How is it diagnosed?

A doctor will conduct a strep test.

#### How is it treated?

Antibiotics are often used to treat strep throat. Ibuprofen may be given for pain.

#### How can it be prevented?

Avoid close contact with contagious people. Children may return to school 24 hours after antibiotics have been started


