
<u>Parents, Grandparents, Guardians,</u> <u>babysitters</u>.....


Year books are in! They will be distributed to the children in a timely manner. We have a very limited number of extra books, so if you still want one order it quickly. The cost is 20\$



L-P: Finger desserts (Chips, Cookies, Brownies, Etc.)


Q-Z: Fruit or veggie platter


