SCHOOL SUPPLIES NEEDED FOR EACH STUDENT

Please refrain from sending extra items to school with your child that is not specifically requested by your child's teacher. Sadly, despite best intentions, property at school can occasionally be lost or misused. Cluttering a desk or backpack with extra materials can contribute to this problem. Please feel free to set up a workstation in your home where your child can use these extra learning supplies.

KINDERGARTEN

- Small pencil box **with child's name on it** to hold crayons, pencil and eraser; make sure the box will fit in a small desk.
- 1 pair of blunt end child's scissors to keep in the classroom **with child's name written on them**.
- 4 boxes of 16 count Crayola crayons in the standard colors. 1 box will be shared with the class. **Please write child's name on 3 of the boxes.**
- 1 large eraser to keep in pencil box, **please write child's name on it.**
- 2 pocket folders (plastic or polyvinyl) and a backpack to transport homework to and from school **with child's name on folders and backpack.**
- 2 glue sticks
- 1 package (4) dry erase markers assorted colors
- 2 rolls of paper towels
- 1 package disinfectant wipes
- 1 box of tissue to share with the class
- 2 packages of baby wipes for glue mess clean-up

Please write names on pencil boxes, scissors, 16 count crayon boxes, folders and erasers.

FIRST

- Small pencil box
- 1 pair of child's scissors
- 2 erasers
- 3 boxes of 24 crayons
- 2 packages of anti-bacterial wipes
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 1 pack of hand wipes
- 1 plain wooden ruler with inches and centimeters
- 2 glue sticks
- 2 plastic pocket folders for homework
- 1 wide ruled composition notebook
- 2 dry erase markers
- Backpack with child's name on it

SECOND

Please write names on folders, crayons, ruler, backpack and scissors

- Small PLASTIC pencil BOX with child's name on it to hold crayons, pencils, and scissors. Make sure the box will fit in a small desk. PLEASE NO ZIP UP POUCH STYLE PENCIL CASES.
- 1 pair of blunt end child's scissors to keep in the pencil box
- 4 boxes of 16 or 24 count Crayola crayons set in standard colors (Labeled with child's name)
- 5 plastic or vinyl pocket folders (Please NO paper folders)
- Backpack to transport homework
- 1 ruler with inches and centimeters (NOT flexible)
- 1 dozen TICONDEROGA brand pencils (to be turned into the teacher)
These are real wood pencils. They sharpen well and do not break easily.
- 2 black EXPO Chisel Tip dry erase markers (to be turned into the teacher)

- 3 boxes of baby wipes for glue messes (to be turned into the teacher)
- 3 containers of disinfecting wipes (to be turned into the teacher)
- 4 boxes of tissues to share with the class (to be turned into the teacher)
- 1 package of multicolored construction paper
- 3 glue sticks
- 2 pink erasers

THIRD

Kept in desk with student

- Backpack
- Small pencil box
- Scissors
- 4 packages of 24 pack of Crayola crayons (These are distributed to your child every quarter as their crayons get worn out.)
- Reusable water bottle
- Ruler (inches and centimeters)

To be turned in:

- 2 dozen Ticonderoga Pencils
- 2 red pens
- 6 glue sticks
- 5 folders with pockets (vinyl or plastic)
- 2 skinny dry erase markers
- 2 boxes of tissues
- 2 packages of disinfectant wipes
- 2 packages of wipes (safe for skin)
- 1 package of wide ruled lined paper
- 2 packages of paper towels
- 1 package of pink erasers

FOURTH

- 1 Large Standard Eraser
- 1 Scissors
- 6 Glue Sticks
- 1 Wooden Ruler (Inches and Centimeters)
- 1 Box of Wide Line Markers – Basic Colors (Please No Bold or Pastel)
- 2 Blue or Green pens
- 1 Box Colored Pencils (12)-Sharpened
- 2 Boxes Crayola Crayons
- 2 yellow Highlighters
- 6 Dry Erase Markers
- 1 Clean Sock or Dry Erase Eraser
- 4 Two Pocket Plain Folders (1 Red, 1 Blue, 1 Green, and 1 Yellow) (3-Hole Punched, Without Fasteners)
- 3 Spiral Notebooks – Wide-Ruled (1 Red, 1 Blue, 1 Green)
- 1 Three Subject Notebook
- 4 Package Post-It Notes - 3" x 3" 90 sheets each – No Pop-Ups
- 2 Large Boxes of Facial Tissues
- 1 Pencil Pouch
- 1 Pencil Box

FIFTH

1-2 packages of **WIDE RULE** Notebook paper

1 Doz. #2 **Ticonderoga** pencils to share with class.

Mechanical pencils with lead – OPTIONAL/FOR STUDENT

4 **100 sheets each** spiral notebooks

1 plastic, heavy duty pocket folder for homework

5 pocket folders for student's desk

1-2 highlighters to share with the class

ABSOLUTELY NO MARKERS OF ANY KIND. Any markers brought to school must be turned in to the teachers and will be confiscated.

Items to be turned in:

- 3 highlighters
- 6 boxes of tissues
- 3 containers of Clorox wipes (or similar)
- 4 dry erase markers
- 1 box of colored pencils (12-24 count)
- 1 package of graph paper

Items to be kept in student's backpack:

- 2 red pens
- 10 pencils for personal use by students
- 2 highlighters
- 4 1 ½ inch binders for Social Studies, Science, Spanish, and English (any color)

- 1 Texas Instrument TI30 calculator for math

- 1 package of pens(color black or blue)
- 2 rolls of tape
- Scissors
