The Golden Plate Awards program is not a rating system, and participation is voluntary. The award recognizes establishments which strive for excellence in food safety standards. While all food establishments in the county meet the minimum Food Code requirements, there are few who consistently excel; We are joined by the Yavapai County Food Safety Industry Council and the University of Arizona Cooperative Extension in commending you and your staff for your exceptional food handling practices. Typically, award recipients receive public acknowledgement at the Board of Supervisors meetings, however, in light of ongoing COVID-19 mitigations, we are mailing your award for prompt exhibition in your establishment. Thank you for consistent dedication to safely serving your community.

The Board of Supervisors will be presented with the list of Golden Plate winners for the Prescott side of the mountain on March 2, 2022, and on the Verde side on March 16, 2022. You may attend the meeting VIRTUALLY at [www.yavapaiaz.gov/meetings](http://www.yavapaiaz.gov/meetings) starting at 9:00AM.

All fixed Yavapai County establishments that are eligible for the Award must have had an Annual License to Operate for the entire 12 months and had at least one routine inspection during the calendar year (not including 90-day Provisional Permit inspections).

There are three criteria for receiving The Golden Plate:

- 1) No routine inspections during the calendar year were cited Priority violation or Priority Foundation violation.
- 2) An approved and implemented food safety plan.
- 3) Manager Certification in food safety principles in accordance with Yavapai County Health Code

You may proudly display this award in your establishment as long as you remain the license holder of record – it is not revocable. However, the certificate itself remains the property of Yavapai County Community Health Services and may not be displayed by a subsequent license holder, as in the case of an ownership change. 231 Yavapai County food establishments have earned the **2021 Golden Plate Award**. This is the sixteenth year of the award, and to be eligible, an owner or operator needed to meet three criteria:

- 1) Operate throughout the entire calendar year 2021 without a cited priority or priority foundation food handling violation.
- 2) Have an approved and implemented food safety plan.
- 3) Have a person-in-charge with an accepted and current manager-level food safety certificate through-out the year.
