25th School Anniversary

The Franklin Phonetic School has been open for 25 years now. They first opened in 1996, we were only a K-3rd school and only had about 118 students to start with, now the school has more than 450 students. The Franklin's only owned half of the elementary/Health Aid building. There are only four staff members who have been here since the beginning. Dr. Franklin and Mr. Franklin taught kindergarten, Mrs. Goeke taught Pre-K, and Ms. A. Young was a teacher aide. The only sport they had was P.E. on a 30x30 playground with equipment that they still use today. Dr. Franklin led Music and Holiday shows at a local church because they didn't have the space. Because of this, most assemblies were held outside. They only had one after school class where they would play games, do homework, and sing songs. This year is the 25th anniversary of our school and a lot has changed since the very beginning.
