Contest submissions can be made to any participating school or organization, or mailed directly to MATFORCE, 8056 E. Valley Road, Suite B, Prescott Valley 86314.
- Entries must be 8 ½" x 5 ½" (half sheet).
- Contest submissions shall be an original creation of the submitter with the theme *Say No to Underage Drinking*. It can be hand drawn or computer drawn, but it must be an original design. Design cannot contain copyrighted images.
- Contest submissions shall have the following information written on the back:
 - Artist's full name (first and last)
 - Grade
 - Organization (school, club, association or home school)
 - Contact phone number

Submissions without the above information will NOT be entered into the contest.

- An overall winning selection will be chosen from ALL submissions by the Underage Drinking Task Force of MATFORCE. Winners will be announced by January 16, 2015.
- One winner will be selected in each category:
 - Kindergarten – 2nd Grade
 - 3 – 5th Grade
 - 6 – 8th Grade
 - 9 – 12th Grade
- The winner in each category will receive a \$100 gift card to Target.
- The winning artwork in each category will be printed and used on the top of pizza boxes in February 2015. The prize winners agree to allow MATFORCE to use his or her name and likeness, as well as the artwork in all media releases and advertisements.
- All artwork submitted becomes the property of MATFORCE.

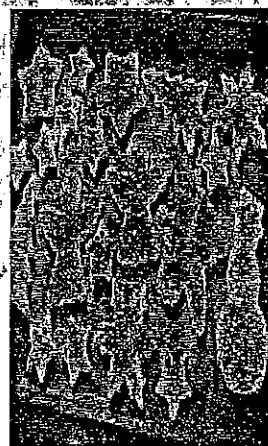

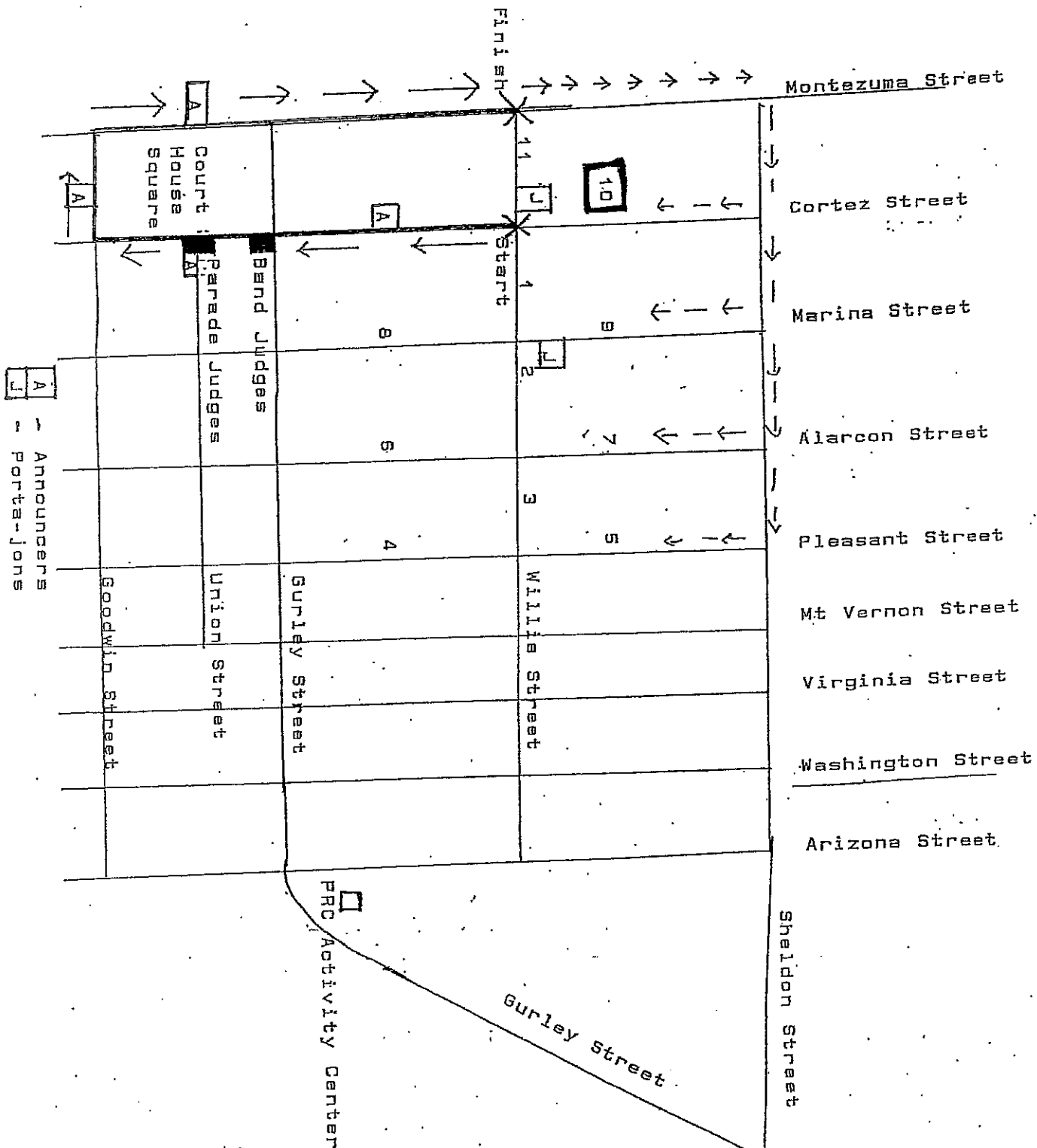
Parade Parents & Students:

Tax Credit Donation Form

The State of Arizona has authorized a tax credit for individuals to donate funds directly to schools. As a Public Charter School donations of up to \$400 for a married couple, or \$200 for a person filing as single or head of household, can be made directly to Franklin Phonetic School for the tax year 2014.

The donations we receive help to support our many fine arts programs, including Beginning Band, Concert Band, Jazz Band, 4/4/5 grades Choir, Junior High Choir, and several levels of Drama.

Franklin School offers an array of sports activities throughout the year. We have joined with local charter schools to form competitive teams in Flag football, Volleyball, Cross country, Basketball, and soccer.

Other donations help trips and special activities. Children who could not otherwise afford the minimal cost of an extracurricular activity are supported through the fund so that all students can participate.

Donations must be received by December 31st in order to be credited to your 2014 tax return.



Tax credit donations from last year provided the opportunity for our junior high students to compete at the Arizona State Citizen Showcase, where our students were awarded first place in the oral presentation category.

During the previous school year, Franklin School placed second place at the Yavapai County Spelling Bee. Participation in the County Spelling Bee was made possible using tax credit donations.

Donations also provided art supplies that allowed our students to work on special art projects and participate in field trips to local art exhibits and museums.

On the Arizona state income tax return, can a taxpayer claim both an itemized deduction and a tax credit for a contribution made to either a public school or a school tuition organization?

No. Any amount claimed as a tax credit cannot be taken as an itemized deduction. However, you may still claim any excess over the amount claimed as a credit as an itemized deduction as long as the contribution did not benefit your dependent.

What is the maximum dollar amount of the credit?

The credit is equal to the amount on Line 30 of your Arizona Tax Return up to the allowable amount per taxpayer.

- For single taxpayers or heads of household, the credit cannot exceed \$200. For married taxpayers that file a joint return, the credit cannot exceed \$400 for tax year 2014 and subsequent years.
- If married taxpayers file separate returns, each spouse may claim 1/2 of the credit that would have been allowed on a joint return.

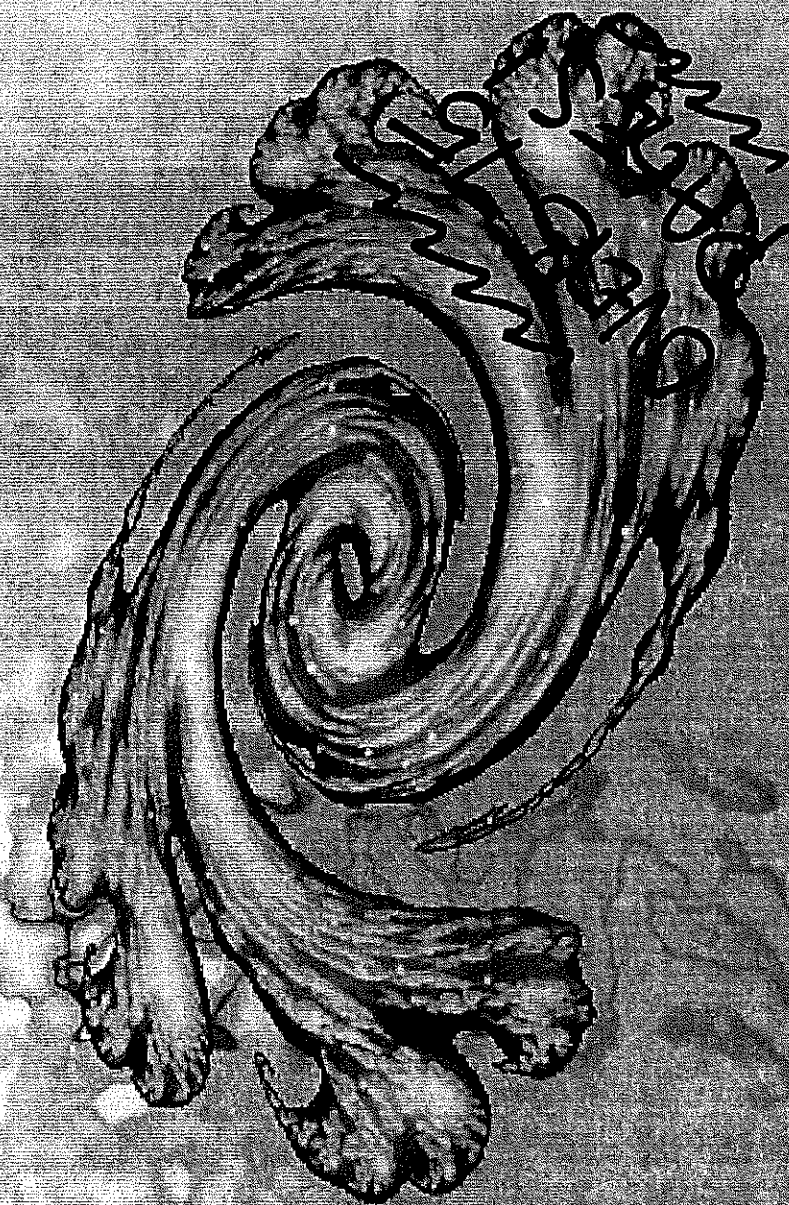
