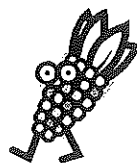

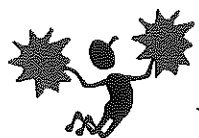
## Our volleyball

Please remember if your child is enrolled in an after school class, make every effort to ensure that they attend. This is because our grant funding for next year is dependent upon our attendance from this school year.

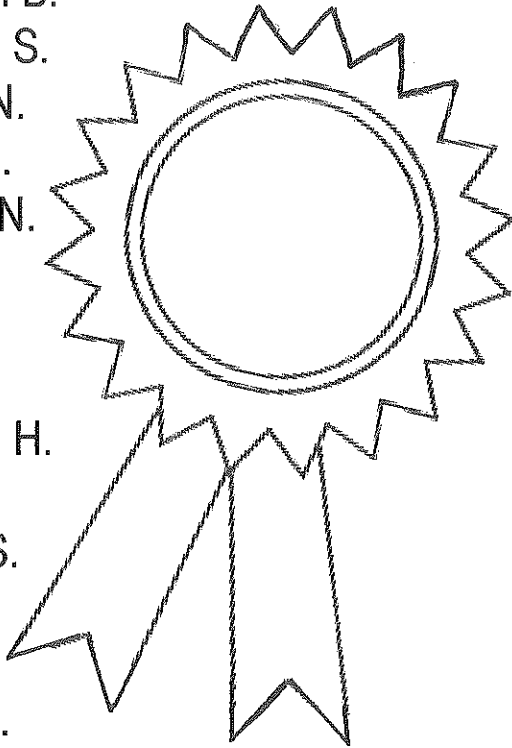

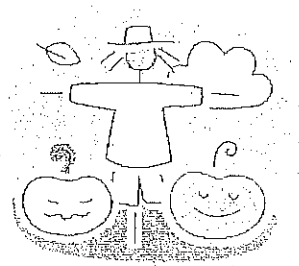
