Parents you **MUST** not be on your hand held cell phone when you are in the pick up or drop off line. This is a serious safety concern as we need your full attention during pick up and drop off.

Pick up and Drop Off Procedures

The town of Prescott Valley **WILL NOT ALLOW** parents to use the Hwy 69 Frontage Road for picking up or dropping of your child/children. You may drop off your child/children in the morning using E. Copper Hill Drive beginning at 7:15. Traffic will flow from WEST to EAST. The E. Copper Hill Drive gates into the school will close at 8:15. If you arrive at school after 8:15 then you will need to drive to the junior high office located on Frontage Road, **PARK AND WALK** your student into the junior high office.

After school dismissal will **ONLY** take place on the elementary side of the school which is located on E. Copper Hill Drive. There will be **NO** dismissal from the junior high office located on Frontage Road. Do not arrive to pick up your elementary child before 2:45 PM. The gates will be closed until 2:45 PM.

You must approach the school for pickup using Stoneridge Drive and get into the line to turn onto E. Copper Hill Drive. Then pull off to the right-side easement to avoid blocking traffic. DO NOT turn right onto E. Copper Hill Road from N. Aaron Drive and cut into traffic that is pulled off to the right side of E. Copper Hill Road.
