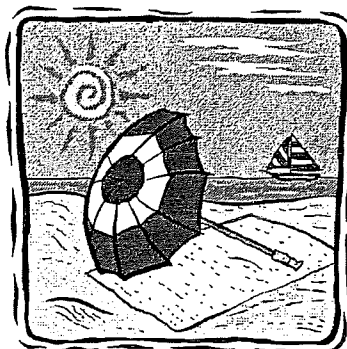

- ✓ Children with AHCCCS and KidsCare are eligible
